


Graduate Profile

James's advice



For admission to a programme, standard applicants must:
Have already completed a Level 8 degree or equivalent. Basic computer, web and keyboard skills are essential. Familiarity with social media and media sharing platforms and services are desirable also, as well as an interest in video production, graphic design, and/or interactive media.

About the Course

The Digital Media Design and Development programme provides students with a broad and practical introduction to the world of digital media. A wide range of modern digital media technologies will be presented and applied. A review of the design and development process of related job roles and industries will be undertaken.

The Programme is delivered entirely online using many of the same tools and technologies which also form the course curriculum. This programme may appeal to those who cannot commit to attending regular face to face lectures and labs or who simply find the flexibility and convenience of studying at a distance attractive.

This Certificate Award has also been developed as a bridging route for applicants who are interested in undertaking the Master of Arts in E-learning Design & Development but who do not possess a Level 8 qualification in Digital Media.
